# 2. Play Area Gate

Town Council considered recommendation of Health and Safety Committee meeting held 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2022, regarding play area gate (item originally considered at Town Council meeting October 2021).

Discussions had been held at previous Town Council meetings regarding a second gate to the play area, which would be a self-closing safety gate.

Information had been requested from Mon CC regarding DDA requirements for an additional gate. It had been confirmed that the gate would meet compliance (minimum width 1.2mtr and yellow or red for visibility).

No concerns had been raised regarding the location of the gate, although it was noted that it would have to open inwards to the park because of the footpath. A councillor expressed concern that the location of the gate could be a health and safety issue.

Upon being put to the vote (9 in favour, 1 against, 1 abstention) it was agreed to proceed with second play area gate.

Town Council resolved to approve installation of second play area gate.
